Dear President Vurdien:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting June 4-6, 2014, reviewed the Midterm Report submitted by Fullerton College. The Midterm Report was certified by District and College leadership, including the president of the governing board, the Chancellor, the College president, and leaders of the faculty, staff, and student organizations.

Based on the College Midterm Report and the documentation submitted, the Commission finds the College has previously resolved the deficiencies associated with District Recommendations 1, 2, and 3 and College Recommendations 1 through 5, sustained the changes, and is in continued compliance with Accreditation Standards.

Institutions are expected to meet Eligibility Requirements, Accreditation Standards, and Commission policies at all times during the six-year cycle. It is expected that the changes and improvements noted in the Midterm Report will continue to be sustained. This will be verified at the time of the next regularly scheduled visit. Fullerton College will submit its next Institutional Self Evaluation of Educational Quality and Institutional Effectiveness Report in preparation for the comprehensive review in **March 2017**. Please note that the comprehensive evaluations will be based upon the Accreditation Standards adopted in June 2014.

The Midterm Report submitted in March 2014 will become part of the accreditation history of the College. The Commission requires that you give the Midterm Report and this letter appropriate dissemination to your College staff and to those who were signatories of your Midterm Report. This group should include the Chancellor, campus leadership, and the Board of Trustees.

The Commission also requires that the Midterm Report and this Commission action letter be made available to students and the public by placing a copy on the College website. *Please note that in response to public interest in disclosure, the Commission now requires institutions to post accreditation information on a page no farther than one click from the institution's home page.*
