INFORM	١	If the agent presents a warrant or subpoena, inform the agent that you are not obstructing their process and do not have the authority to respond to the request.
		Call Risk Management/ Vice President of Administrative Services at 714-992-7018. Vice President Henry Hua is the only campus official designated to review federal warrants and subpoenas.
		If the contact occurs outside of business hours, call Risk Management or Campus Safety.
		If possible, provide Risk Management or Campus Safety with the agency affiliation, number of agents, and other identifying information.
