ELIGIBLITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to participate in this Study Abroad Program, the following requirements must be completed by the Fall 2025 semester:

- Successfully complete ENGL C1000 (formerly ENGL 100) or equivalent with a grade "C" or better.
- Complete 12 college units in a semester.
- Demonstrate academic success at the college level.
- Be at least 18 years of age.
